



Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Email to Students

Good morning,

SunTech was a recipient of Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The funds received are to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care). In order to qualify, a student must be Title IV eligible to receive these grants. This includes:

- Must be US Citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen
- Must have a valid SSN
- Must be registered with Selective Service, if applicable
- Must have a HS Diploma or recognized equivalent

The total check amount for each student is \$179.40. **In order for Hernando Schools to issue you the check, you will need to complete the attached W9 form and mail it back to our offices by May 27th.**

Once we receive the W9 forms, we will contact you with instructions for pick up. Please note, if you already receive a Pell grant from our institution, you will **not** need to complete a new W9. The forms must be mailed to our main office at 801 N. Broad Street, Brooksville, FL 34601.
